

## **MOVIES! Network signs five new affiliates in Charlotte, Salt Lake City, Boise, Wausau, and Victoria**

WJZY-DT-Charlotte, North Carolina (DMA #25), owned by Fox Television Stations, will launch on July 1, 2014 and will be seen on over the air channel 46.2, Time Warner Cable channel 147, Comporium Cable channel 120, Charter channel 80, SkyBest TV channel 262, CoMPAS channel 113/143, RST Fiber channel 8, and Lenoir-Rhyne College channel 46.

KUCW-DT-Salt Lake City, Utah (DMA #33), owned by Nexstar Broadcasting, launched on May 1, 2014 and is seen on over the air channel 30.2 and Comcast channel 106.

KTRV-DT-Boise, Idaho (DMA #110), owned by Idaho Independent Television, will launch on September 6, 2014 and will be seen on over the air channel 12.3 and Cable One channel 489.

WFXS-DT-Wausau-Rhineland, Wisconsin (DMA #135), owned by Davis Television Wausau, will launch on October 1, 2014 and will be seen over the air on channel 55.3 and Charter channel 964.

KMOL-LD-Victoria, Texas (DMA #203), owned by Saga Broadcasting, launched on June 1, 2014 and is seen on over the air channel 17.2 and Comcast channel 104.

"We are excited to add these five stations to our affiliate group," said Maura Cope, Head of Distribution for the Network. "Viewers in these markets will now have the opportunity to enjoy watching great uncut movie classics on broadcast television."
