Later, a woman arrives in town accusing Blaisdell and Morgan of having murdered her fiancé; the stage is set for a complex set of moral and personal conflicts. Adapted by Robert Alan Aurthur from a novel by Oakley Hall, WARLOCK is a good example of the "thinking man's westerns" that were popular in the 1950s and 1960s. <i>Featuring: Richard Widmark, Henry Fonda</i>
