Adapted by Robert Alan Aurthur from a novel by Oakley Hall, WARLOCK is a good example of the "thinking man's westerns" that were popular in the 1950s and 1960s.

Mitch also devises retribution for the townspeople: he enlists the help of some shady characters to rob the bank, which will render the town destitute. But his greed betrays him when he turns on his own gang.
